### Rookies – Majors: Playing Division Guidelines

- As a general rule the playing division for each player will be determined by the players **League Age**.
- It is not uncommon for players to remain in a lower division another year to develop additional skills before moving up. Players at the minimum league age for their division based on birthdate wanting to remain in a lower division should attend assessments for the division defined by their league age.†
- On rare occasions, if the player meets the maximum league age year in their playing division **AND** there is room/team roster availability in the next higher division **AND** the player has attended division assessments defined by their league age **AND** the player has attended division assessments for the next higher division **AND** the players experience and skills warrant (as determined during player assessments by the player agent(s)), the player may be eligible to play-up to the next higher division. Our goal is to ensure player safety and player enjoyment, trying to create fair and balanced teams.†
